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PINE CAR DERBY

Dear Parents,

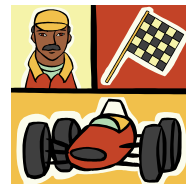
The time is fast approaching for the **Pine Car Derby, which will be held on Sunday, March 5th at the Madison Campus Elementary gymnasium, beginning at 9:00 a.m.** The purpose of this letter is to provide you with some of the details about the event. **Registration of cars will take place during school hours on Friday, March 3rd.** Cars may also be registered on Friday afternoon until the end of After School Care (4 p.m.) and by appointment on Saturday night. A registration period for individuals racing in the Open Division will be held on Saturday night from 6:30-8:30 p.m. and on Sunday morning between 7:30 a.m. and 8:45 a.m. **Students who do not register their car on Friday or Saturday night may also register them on Sunday morning between 7:30 a.m. and 8:45 a.m., but will be allowed to race only in the Open Division and will not be eligible to win money prizes.**

Once the pine cars are registered, they will be transferred to a secure holding location and cannot be further manipulated or adjusted. The only exception to this latter rule is if the car suffers a mishap during a race. If this happens, a race official will give permission for the car to be “serviced” in the pit area. As you work with your children in preparing their cars for the race, please remember that the weight of the car cannot exceed 142 grams and that only dry graphite can be used to lubricate the wheels. Each student must also have raised a minimum of \$50 to race a car. Cars which do not adhere to these rules will not be allowed to race. If you have further questions, please refer to the printed material concerning racing guidelines and rules that were sent home with your child in January. Beginning on Wednesday, February 22, a digital gram scale will be available at school that can be used to weigh your child’s car. On race day, the cars will be judged for design and appearance beginning at around 8:45 a.m., and at approximately 9 a.m., race festivities will begin.

We hope that a large amount of money is raised to support MCE. The final tally of money used to determine fundraising prizes and awards will include money received at the school up to and including Friday, March 3. Money received after that date will be applied to the overall fundraising total for the school, but will not count towards individual money and trophy prizes.
