PHYSICAL EDUCATION NEWS

This week we are concluding a short unit of volleyball skills. Students in grades 3-8 are playing games that incorporate some of the rules and skills used in a regulation volleyball game. Grades K-2 are playing modified throw and catch games with beach balls utilizing volleyball skills. Next Tuesday, March 7, all grades will take the physical fitness test of the “beeps” which tests your children’s cardiovascular endurance and ability to pace themselves over an extended period. This evaluation will comprise part of the 3rd 9 weeks grade. **Basketball intramurals will start next Thursday, March 9.** Grades K-4 will play at 3:00 p.m. and grades 5-8 will play at 3:50 p.m. If you are interested in being a parent helper during our basketball season, please contact Dr. Morgan. **Students must have a permission slip signed by a parent or guardian in order to participate. PINE CAR DERBY

As of Monday, February 27, \$12,900 has been raised towards our goal !!

The Pine Car Derby will be held this coming Sunday, March 5, starting at 9:00 a.m. Registration of cars will take place during school hours on Friday, March 3. Cars may also be registered on Friday afternoon until 4 pm and by appointment on Saturday night from 6:30-8:30 pm and on Sunday morning between 7:30 am and 8:45 am. **Students who do not register their car on Friday or Saturday night may also register them on Sunday morning between 7:30 and 8:45 am, but will be allowed to race only in the Open Division and will not be eligible to win money prizes.** There is a \$50 registration fee for each car, whether it is racing or only entered in the design/appearance contest. (All cars eligible to race are automatically entered in the design/appearance contest.) If your student does not see a car with his/her name on it up on the "Ready to Race" device in the hallway, please check with Mrs. Knecht to see how much money is lacking. Your child will not be allowed to register on Friday until \$50 has been credited to his/her name.
