**PE NEWS**

This week the emphasis has been on overhand throwing technique. In each grade we took time to “mime” a correct throwing motion without a ball and then practiced throwing using small, light-weight balls. Students were instructed to throw as hard and as fast as possible.

The fitness evaluation portion of the PE grade for the final 9 weeks of school will be a continuous timed run. Students will be evaluated on their ability to set a reasonable pace that allows them to jog the entire distance, rather than starting out too fast and having to stop and walk. The lower grades will be working up to running for 6 min. continuously, while the upper grades will run for 8 min. This week we started the process of working up to that goal by completing two, one-minute continuous runs. The other portion of the fitness evaluation will be composed of a 30-second sit-up timing and a pushup evaluation where students perform as many “perfect” pushups as possible. Students intramurals will begin this Thurs. at 3 pm in the Academy field. **Please note that for this sport 3rd graders are allowed the option to play with the older group at the 3:50 time. Students wishing to participate must turn in a signed permission slip, available in the school office.**

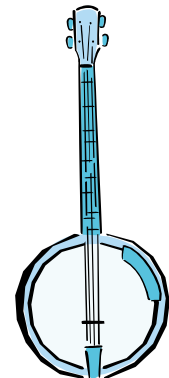
